### ANNUAL SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

#### **GUIDELINES**

- 1. Applicants for the Alumni Scholarship must be accepted to NCCU.
- 2. Applicants must be a Wake County resident.
- 3. Applicants must be a graduating senior.
- 4. Applicants for the Alumni Scholarship must have at least a <u>2.5 GPA</u> and a SAT or equivalent Test Score <u>900 orabove</u>.
- 5. Financial need is not the primary criteria in determining recipients for the award.
- 6. All applications for the Alumni Scholarship must be submitted to the Scholarship Committee by **April 16** and include:
  - a. A completed Alumni Scholarship Application Form
  - b. An official High School transcript
  - c. Applicants with special talents should submit appropriate documentation with reference to talent area and degree of proficiency
  - d. Recommendations from two individuals. At least one reference should be from school personnel. A reference cannot be a relative.
- 7. Each applicant will be interviewed by the scholarship committee: three alumni members and the president of the chapter.
